**1. Roll Call**

During this expulsion, this student may attend alternative classes. Parents are required to provide transportation. This student is not permitted to be on school property unless authorized by the principal.

Mr. Ballard made a motion to approve the superintendent's recommendation. Mr. Withrow seconded the motion and it passed unanimously.
