1. Roll Call

The Summers County Board of Education met in a special meeting on May 12, 2010, 10:30 a.m. in the board office conference room with Ms. Sue Angell, board president, presiding over the meeting with the following board members present: Mr. David Ballard and Mr. James Withrow.

2. Invocation/Pledge of Allegiance

3. Approval of Agenda

Upon a motion by Mr. Ballard, seconded by Mr. Withrow and by unanimous vote, the agenda was approved.

4. Expulsion Hearings

This was an open hearing.

Mrs. Hinerman recommended that one Summers County High School male student 510023350 be expelled for twelve consecutive months, for a violation of 18A-5-1a, and 61-6-17, the School Laws of West Virginia, the Summers County Safe and Orderly Schools Student Conduct Policy, and the State Code of Conduct. During this expulsion, this student may attend alternative classes. Parents are required to provide transportation. This student is not permitted to be on school property unless authorized by the principal. Parents may request a hearing at the end of the first semester next year to ask for reinstatement for second semester.

Mr. Ballard made a motion to approve the superintendent's recommendation. Mr. Withrow seconded the motion and it passed unanimously.
