SPECIAL MEETING MINUTES
December 29, 2011
9:30 a.m.

1. Roll Call

The Summers County Board of Education met in a special meeting on December 29, 2011, 9:30 a.m. in the board office conference room with Ms. Sue Angell, board president, presiding over the meeting with the following board members present: Mr. David Ballard, Dr. Deborah Clark, Mrs. Jean Gore, and Mr. James Withrow.

2. Invocation/Pledge of Allegiance

The invocation was given by Mr. Ballard and followed by the "Pledge of Allegiance."

3. Approval of Agenda

Upon a motion by Mr. Ballard seconded by Mr. Withrow and by unanimous vote, the agenda was approved.

4. Expulsion Hearing

This was an open hearing.

Mr. Durnan presented facts concerning this case and recommended expulsion.

Mrs. Hinerman recommended that one Summers Middle School female student #810005215 be expelled for the remainder of the 2011-2012 school year for a violation of 18A-5-1a, the School Laws of West Virginia, the Summers County Safe and Orderly Schools Student Conduct Policy, and the State Code of Conduct. During this expulsion, this student may be provided homebound services or attend alternative classes. Parents are required to provide transportation for attending alternative classes. This student is not permitted to be on school property unless authorized by the principal.

Mr. Withrow made a motion to approve the superintendent's recommendation. Mr. Ballard seconded the motion and it passed unanimously.

5. Adjournment

Upon a motion by Dr. Clark, seconded by Mrs. Gore and by unanimous vote, the meeting was adjourned.
