1. Roll Call

2. Invocation/Pledge of Allegiance

Done at the previous regular meeting this morning.

3. Approval of Agenda

Upon a motion by Dr. Clark, seconded by Mr. Ballard and by unanimous vote, the agenda was approved.

4. Expulsion Hearing

This was an open hearing.

Mrs. Hinerman presented facts concerning this case and there were recommendations by the attorney, Geoffrey Wilcher.

Mrs. Hinerman recommended that one Summers County High School male student #510026028 be expelled for the remainder of the 2010-2011 school year and the first semester of the 2011-2012 school year for a violation of 18A-5-1a, the School Laws of West Virginia, the Summers County Safe and Orderly Schools Student Conduct Policy, and the State Code of Conduct. The parents of this student may request a reinstatement hearing prior to the beginning of the first semester. During this expulsion, this student will be provided alternative education. Mrs. Hinerman will work with the parents on an acceptable time schedule and transportation arrangement. This student is not permitted to be on school property unless authorized by the principal

Mr. Withrow made a motion to approve the superintendent's recommendation. Dr. Clark seconded the motion and it passed unanimously.
