

**Summers County Board of Education**  
**SPECIAL MEETING MINUTES**  
**October 12, 2011**  
**9:30 a.m.**

**1. Roll Call**

The Summers County Board of Education met in a special meeting on October 12, 2011, 9:30 a.m. in the board office conference room with Ms. Sue Angell, board president, presiding over the meeting with the following board members present: Mr. David Ballard, Dr. Deborah Clark, Mrs. Jean Gore, and Mr. James Withrow.

Other staff members present: Mrs. Vicki Hinerman, *Superintendent*; Mr. David Quisenberry, *Director of Attendance*; and Ms. Kimberly J. Rodes, *Director of Student Services*

Principal attending: Mr. Joshua Houchins, Principal, Summers County High School

**2. Invocation/Pledge of Allegiance**

The invocation was given by Mr. Ballard and followed by the "Pledge of Allegiance."

**3. Approval of Agenda**

Upon a motion by Mr. Ballard seconded by Mr. Withrow and by unanimous vote, the agenda was approved.

**4. Expulsion Hearing**

This was an open hearing.

Mr. Houchins and Mr. Ryan presented facts concerning this case and recommended expulsion.

Following the hearing, Mr. Withrow made a motion to go into executive session for the purpose of deliberation, pursuant to 6-9A-4 (3). Mr. Ballard seconded the motion and it passed unanimously.

Upon returning to the public session, Mrs. Hinerman recommended that one Summers County High School male student #510030734 be expelled for the remainder of the 2011-2012 school year for a violation of 18A-5-1a, the School Laws of West Virginia, the Summers County Safe and Orderly Schools Student Conduct Policy, and the State Code of Conduct. During this expulsion, this student may attend alternative classes. Parents are required to provide transportation. This student is not permitted to be on school property unless authorized by the principal.

Mr. Withrow made a motion to approve the superintendent's recommendation. Mr. Ballard seconded the motion and it passed unanimously.

**5. Adjournment**

Upon a motion by Dr. Clark, seconded by Mr. Ballard and by unanimous vote, the meeting was adjourned.
