SPECIAL MEETING MINUTES
September 14, 2011
9:00 a.m.

1. Roll Call

The Summers County Board of Education met in a special meeting on September 14, 2011, 9:00 a.m. in the board office conference room with Ms. Sue Angell, board president, presiding over the meeting with the following board members present: Mr. David Ballard, Dr. Deborah Clark, Mrs. Jean Gore, and Mr. James Withrow.

Other staff members present: Mrs. Vicki Hinerman, *Superintendent*; Dr. Sarah Brown, *Director of Curriculum*; Mr. David Quisenberry, *Director of Attendance*; Mrs. Jennifer Farley, *Business Manager*; and Jay McBride, *Transportation Director*.

2. Invocation/Pledge of Allegiance

The invocation was given by Mr. Ballard and followed by the "Pledge of Allegiance."

3. Approval of Agenda

Upon a motion by Mr. Ballard seconded by Mr. Withrow and by unanimous vote, the agenda was approved.

4. Expulsion Hearing

This was an open hearing.

Mr. Houchins presented facts concerning this case and recommended expulsion.

Following the hearing, Mr. Ballard made a motion to go into executive session for the purpose of deliberation, pursuant to 6-9A-4 (3). Mr. Withrow seconded the motion and it passed unanimously.

Upon returning to the public session, Mrs. Hinerman recommended that one Summers County High School male student #740024183 be expelled for the remainder of the 2011-2012 school year for a violation of 18A-5-1a, the School Laws of West Virginia, the Summers County Safe and Orderly Schools Student Conduct Policy, and the State Code of Conduct. During this expulsion, this student will be provided homebound services. An at-risk assessment will be scheduled for this student prior to him returning to school. This student is not permitted to be on school property unless authorized by the principal.

Mr. Ballard made a motion to approve the superintendent's recommendation. Mr. Withrow seconded the motion and it passed unanimously.

5. Adjournment

Upon a motion by Dr. Clark, seconded by Mr. Withrow and by unanimous vote, the meeting was adjourned.
