

Summers County Board of Education
SPECIAL MEETING MINUTES
September 12, 2012 9:00 a.m.

1. Roll Call

The Summers County Board of Education met in a special meeting on September 12, 2012, 9:00 a.m. in the board office conference room with Ms. Sue Angell, board president, presiding over the meeting with the following board members present: Mr. David Ballard, Dr. Deborah Clark, Mrs. Jean Gore, and Mr. James Withrow.

Other staff members present: Mrs. Vicki Hinerman, *Superintendent*; Mr. David Quisenberry, *Director of Attendance*; Ms. Kimberly J. Rodes, *Director of Student Services*; Mrs. Jennifer Farley, *Business Manager*; and Jay McBride, *Transportation Director*.

Assistant Principals attending: Mr. Wayne Ryan, Assistant Principal, Summers County High School and Ms. Karla Gunnoe, Assistant Principal, Summers County High School

2. Invocation/Pledge of Allegiance

The invocation was given by Mr. Ballard and followed by the "Pledge of Allegiance."

3. Approval of Agenda

Upon a motion by Mr. Ballard seconded by Mrs. Gore and by unanimous vote, the agenda was approved.

4. Expulsion Hearings

HEARING I

The family requested a closed hearing.

Mrs. Hinerman requested the board go into executive session for the purpose of an expulsion hearing, pursuant to 6-9A-4.

Mr. Ballard made a motion to go into executive session. Mr. Withrow seconded the motion and it passed unanimously.

Ms. Gunnoe presented the facts concerning this case and recommended that student ID #810005085 be expelled for a 365 day period for a violation of 18A-5-1a.

Upon returning to the public session, Mrs. Hinerman recommended that one Summers County High School male student ID#810005085 be expelled for the remainder of the 2012-2013 school term for a violation of *18A-5-1a, the School Laws of West Virginia* and the *Summers County Safe and Orderly Schools Student Conduct Policy*. During this expulsion, this student may attend alternative classes and counseling sessions. Parents are required to provide transportation. This student is not permitted to be on school property unless authorized by the principal.

Mr. Ballard made a motion to approve the superintendent's recommendation. Mr. Withrow seconded the motion and it passed unanimously.

HEARING II

Mr. Ryan presented the facts concerning this case and recommended that student ID #810004421 be expelled for a violation of 18A-5-1a.

Mrs. Hinerman recommended that one Summers County High School female student ID#810004421 be expelled for the remainder of the 2012-2013 school term for a violation of *18A-5-1a, the School Laws of West Virginia* and the *Summers County Safe and Orderly Schools Student Conduct Policy*. This student will be provided homebound services when she returns to the area. This student is not permitted to be on school property unless authorized by the principal.

Mr. Withrow made a motion to approve the superintendent's recommendation. Dr. Clark seconded the motion and it passed unanimously.

5. Adjournment

Upon a motion by Dr. Clark, seconded by Mrs. Gore and by unanimous vote, the meeting was adjourned.
