

**Summers County Board of Education  
SPECIAL MEETING MINUTES**

**January 8, 2014**

**9:30 a.m.**

**1. Roll Call**

The Summers County Board of Education met in a special meeting on January 8, 2014, 9:30 a.m. in the board office conference room with Ms. Sue Angell, Board President, presiding over the meeting with the following board members present: Mr. David Ballard, Dr. Deborah Clark, Mrs. Jean Gore, and Mr. James Withrow.

**2. Invocation/Pledge of Allegiance**

►The invocation was given by Mr. Ballard and followed by the "Pledge of Allegiance."

**3. Approval of Agenda**

►Upon a motion made by Mr. Withrow, seconded by Mrs. Gore and by unanimous vote, the agenda was approved.

**4. Expulsion Hearing**

►The family requested an open hearing, following the hearing Mr. Ballard made a motion to go into executive session, pursuant 6-9A-4, seconded by Mr. Withrow, and by unanimous vote.

Upon returning to regular session, Mr. Duman recommended that the student, ID # 810005810, be expelled for a 365 day period for a violation of 18A-5-1a, *The School Laws of West Virginia and the Summers County Policy VII-A-10, Expected Behavior in Safe and Supportive Schools* with the option to reapply to school next year. Mrs. Hinerman agreed with Mr. Duman's recommendation. This student is not permitted to be on school property unless authorized by the principal. The time and place of educational services will be decided at a meeting including the parent, Ms. Kimberly Rodes, Director of Student Services and Mr. Kitrick Duman, Principal of Summers Middle School.

Mr. Ballard made a motion to approve the superintendent's recommendation, Mr. Withrow seconded the motion and it passed unanimously.
