**Disseminating and Collecting Information (Public Relations)**

The Summers County Board of Education believes that, to function most effectively, information must be disseminated to the public and in turn the board must receive public input. This transfer of information is not just a program, but is a process in which all employees of the school system and all citizens participate.

Information may be transmitted and received in various ways. These include, but are not limited to, public appearance at board meetings, press releases, news articles, newsletters, surveys, public hearings, and public access to minutes and other information.

In addition, the central office administration maintains an "open door" policy and will discuss educational issues and concerns with involved parties during regular working hours.
