

Summers County Board of Education  
SPECIAL Meeting Minutes  
January 7, 2015  
9:30 a.m.

1. **Roll Call**

The Summers County Board of Education met in a special meeting on January 7, 2015, 9:30 a.m. in the board office conference room with Ms. Sue Angell, Board President, presiding over the meeting with the following board members: Dr. Deborah Clark, Mr. James Withrow, and Mr. James Payne. Mrs. Gore was absent.

Other staff members present: Mrs. Vicki Hinerman, *Superintendent*; Ms. Kimberly Rodes, *Director*; Mr. Michael Tabor, *Director*; Mr. Josh Houchins, *Director*; Mr. Jay McBride, *Director*; and Mrs. Jennifer Farley, *Business Manager*.

2. **Invocation/Pledge of Allegiance**

The invocation was given by Mr. Withrow, followed by the Pledge of Allegiance.

3. **Approval of Agenda**

Upon a motion by Dr. Clark, seconded by Mr. Payne and by unanimous vote, the agenda was approved.

4. **Expulsion Hearing -Number One**

5. **Discussion and/or Action Concerning Expulsion**

Mr. Widdoes, Assistant Principal at Summers County High School presented the findings in the case of student #810005188. Mr. Widdoes recommended expulsion for 365 days for violation of 18A-D-1a., *The Schools Laws of West Virginia and the Summers County Policy VII-A-10, Expected Behavior in Safe and Supportive Schools*. Mrs. Hinerman recommended expulsion for second semester and first semester of the 2016 school term and that he would continue his education in Alternative Education at Summers County High School.

Mr. Payne made a motion to approve the superintendent's recommendation, Mr. Withrow seconded the motion and it passed unanimously.

6. **Expulsion Hearing -Number Two**

►Student ID# 810005342 - Summers County High School

The family requested an open meeting. Mr. Ryan, Assistant Principal of Summers County High School explained the findings in the case of student ID#810005342. Following the hearing, Dr. Clark made a motion to go into executive session, pursuant to 6-9A-4, seconded by Mr. Withrow, and by unanimous vote.

7. **Discussion and/or Action Concerning Expulsion**

Upon returning to regular session, Mr. Ryan and Mrs. Hinerman recommended that the student ID#810005342, be expelled for second semester for violation of 18A-D-1a, *The School Laws of West Virginia and the Summers County Policy VII-A-10, Expected Behavior in Safe and Supportive Schools*. He will continue his education in alternative education at Summers County High School.

Mr. Withrow made a motion to approve the superintendent's recommendation, Mr. Payne seconded the motion and it passed unanimously.
