

Summers County Board of Education
SPECIAL Meeting Minutes
November 19, 2014
9:30 a.m.

1. **Roll Call**

The Summers County Board of Education met in a special meeting on November 19, 2014, 9:30 a.m. in the board office conference room with Ms. Sue Angell, *Board President*, presiding over the meeting with the following board members present: Mrs. Jean Gore, Dr. Deborah Clark, Mr. James Withrow, and Mr. James Payne.

Other staff members present: Mrs. Vicki Hinerman, *Superintendent*; Mr. Josh Houchins, *Director*; Ms. Kimberly Rodes, *Director*; Mr. Michael Tabor, *Director*; and Mrs. Jennifer Farley, *Business Manager*.

2. **Invocation/Pledge of Allegiance**

The invocation was given by Mr. Withrow and followed by the "Pledge of Allegiance."

3. **Approval of Agenda**

Upon a motion by Mr. Payne, seconded by Mrs. Gore and by unanimous vote, the agenda was approved.

4. **Expulsion Hearing**

The family requested a closed hearing. Following the hearing, Dr. Clark made a motion to go into executive session, pursuant to 6-9A-4, seconded by Mrs. Gore, and by unanimous vote.

5. **Discussion and/or Action Concerning Expulsion**

Upon returning to regular session, Mr. Durnan and Mrs. Hinerman recommended that the student ID#810005455, be expelled for a the remainder of the 2014-2015 school term for violation of 18A-D-1a, *The School Laws of West Virginia and the Summers County Policy VII-A-10, Expected Behavior in Safe and Supportive Schools*. They recommended that the student be allowed to attend Alternative Education at Jumping Branch Elementary and for the student to seek counseling.

Mr. Withrow made a motion to approve the superintendent's recommendation, Mr. Payne seconded the motion and is passed unanimously.
