

**Summers County Board of Education**  
**SPECIAL MEETING MINUTES**  
**November 13, 2013**

**1. Roll Call**

The Summers County Board of Education met in a special meeting on November 13, 2013, 9:30 a.m. in the board office conference room with Ms. Sue Angell, Board President, presiding over the meeting with the following board members present: Mr. David Ballard, Dr. Deborah Clark, Mrs. Jean Gore, and Mr. James Withrow.

**2. Invocation/Pledge of Allegiance**

**3. Approval of Agenda**

**4. Expulsion Hearing**

Upon returning to the public session, Mr. Ryan recommended that the student, ID#810004873, be expelled for a 365 day period for a violation of 18A-5-1a, *The School Laws of West Virginia and the Summers County Policy VII-A-10, Expected Behavior in Safe and Supportive Schools*. Mrs. Hinerman agreed with Mr. Ryan's recommendation. This student is not permitted to be on school property unless authorized by the principal. The time and place of educational services will be decided at a meeting including the parent, Ms. Kimberly Rodes, Director of Student Services and Mr. Joshua Houchins, Principal of Summers County High School.

Mr. Ballard made a motion to approve the superintendent's recommendation, Mr. Withrow seconded the motion and it passed unanimously.
