SCHOOL DISTRICT ATTENDANCE AREAS

Each school in the county has been zoned by the Summers County Board of Education for attendance purposes and all pupils are required to attend the school in the attendance area of their residence, with only two exceptions, as follows:

1. A pupil may, because of unusual and justifiable circumstances, be transferred to another school with the approval of the principals involved and the superintendent.
2. Any child living within the boundaries of Summers County shall be allowed to attend the county school of his/her choice, with the Summers County Board of Education providing transportation, provided all of the following conditions are satisfied:
 - (a) said child must enroll at the school of his/her choice at the beginning of the school term
 - (b) transportation shall be along existing bus routes
 - (c) transportation of said child does not cause over crowding on the bus
 - (d) the enrollment of said child in the school of his/her choice does not result in a violation of pupil/teacher ratios

The following attendance areas have been assigned:

1. PreK-4 students living on the Hinton side of the Corner Store at Nimitz come to Hinton Area Elementary. Grade 5 students will attend Summers Middle School.
2. PreK-4 students living beyond the forks of the road at Sand Knob and Leatherwood Road go to Hinton Area Elementary. Grade 5 students will attend Summers Middle School.
3. PreK-5 students living at Big Creek, Willowood Road, and Camp Lightfoot Road go to Talcott.
4. PreK-5 students living at Powleys Creek Tunnel go to Talcott School. The previous K-5 Forest Hill attendance area is assigned as a part of the Talcott attendance area.
5. PreK-4 students living on River Road in Raleigh County and Madams Creek go to Hinton Area Elementary. Grade 5 students will attend Summers Middle School.
6. PreK-4 students living in the Avis area will go to Hinton Area Elementary. Grade 5 students will attend Summers Middle School.
7. PreK-4 students from Willowood Bridge to Bellepoint on Route 3 go to Hinton Area Elementary. Grade 5 students will attend Summers Middle School.
8. PreK-4 students from Burdette residence on Sandstone Mountain go to Hinton Area. Those on Route 20 toward Hinton go to Hinton Area Elementary. Grade 5 students will attend Summers Middle School.
9. PreK-5 students living on Route 7 from Elk Knob Church to Judson Road go to Talcott School.
10. PreK-4 students living on Route 7 from Elk Knob Church to Hix Road go to Hinton Area Elementary. Grade 5 students will attend Summers Middle School.

All Summers County students in grades 9-12 will attend Summers County High School and all Summers County students in grades 6-8 will attend Summers Middle School. Grade 5 students in the Hinton Area Elementary School attendance area will attend Summers Middle School.
