Entrance Age Requirement

A child shall be permitted to enter **Pre-K** if he/she is four years old prior to September 1st, of the current school year.

The following priorities will be used if we should have more students planning to enroll in Pre-K than we have room to serve:

1. First priority will go to those students who are turning four prior to September 1st.
2. Second priority will go to those students who have completed a year in Pre-K but whose parents and the school have determined it is necessary for the child to repeat Pre-K.
3. Third priority will go to those students who are five years old but have not attended Pre-K in the previous school year and whose parents wish for them to attend Pre-K before going to Kindergarten.

A child shall be permitted to enter **Kindergarten** if he/she is five years old prior to September 1st, of the current school year.

A child must be enrolled in kindergarten if he/she is six prior to September 1st, of the current school year.
