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Closed Campus and Granting Permission to Leave School

The Summers County Board of Education realizes that for effective education to take place, students and teachers must be in attendance regularly. However, there are extenuating circumstances that make it necessary for them to leave school during the regular school day. When employees or students leave school during the regular school day, it will be the duty and responsibility of the principal to give permission and maintain documentation.

It shall be the policy of the Summers County Board of Education that students remain on campus during lunch except when picked up by a parent or guardian.
