1. Roll Call

The Summers County Board of Education met in a special meeting on August 19, 2015, 9:30 a.m. in the board office conference room with Dr. Deborah Clark, Vice President, presiding over the meeting with the following board members: Ms. Jean Gore, Ms. Sue Angell, Mr. James Withrow, and Mr. James Payne.

3. Approval of Agenda

5. Discussion and/or Action Concerning Expulsion

Mr. Widdoes presented the facts in the case of the student #810005321 and he recommended expulsion for 365 days.

Ms. Angell made a motion to go into executive session, pursuant to 6-9A-4, seconded by Mr. Payne, and by unanimous vote.

Upon returning to regular session Mrs. Hinerman recommended expulsion for the remainder of the 2015-2016 school year for the violation of 18-A-D-1a, *The Schools Laws of West Virginia and the Summers County Policy VII-A-10, Expected Behavior in Safe and Supportive Schools*. The student will attend the Alternative School, Monday-Thursday, from 3:30-6:30. The Mental Health Services at Summers County High School will be available to him.

Ms. Angell made a motion to approve the superintendent's recommendation, Mr. Withrow seconded the motion and it passed unanimously.
