SPECIAL Meeting Minutes
May 27, 2016
10:00 a.m.

1. Roll Call

The Summers County Board of Education met in a special meeting on May 27, 2016, 10:00 a.m. in the board office conference room with Ms. Sue Angell, President presiding over the meeting with the following board members: Ms. Jean Gore, Dr. Deborah Clark, Mr. James Withrow, and Mr. James Payne.

Other staff members present: Mrs. Vicki Hinerman, Superintendent; Mr. Josh Houchins, Director and Mrs. Jennifer Farley, Business Manager.

Others present: Ms. Susie Hudson, Principal at Summers Middle School
Student ID#810005925 with parent and Student ID# 20010316 with parents.

2. Invocation/Pledge of Allegiance

The invocation was given by Mr. Withrow followed by the Pledge of Allegiance.

3. Approval of Agenda

Upon a motion by Mr. Payne, seconded by Ms. Gore and by unanimous vote, the agenda was approved.

4. Expulsion Hearing Number One

5. Discussion and/or Action Concerning Expulsion

7. Discussion and/or Action Concerning Expulsion

The parents requested a closed hearing.

Dr. Clark made a motion to go into executive session, pursuant to 6-9A-4, seconded by Mr. Withrow, and by unanimous vote.

Ms. Hudson presented the facts in the case of the Student #280010313

Upon returning to regular session, Mrs. Hinerman recommended expulsion for the 2016-2017 school term with the provision that the student attend alternative education and that the parent can request a hearing for the student to return under a behavior contract 2nd semester.

Dr. Clark made a motion to approve the superintendent's recommendation, Mr. Payne seconded the motion and it passed unanimously.

8. Expulsion Hearing Number Three

9. Discussion and/or Action Concerning Expulsion

This was an open hearing. Ms. Hudson recommended expulsion for 12 months.

Mrs. Hinerman recommended an extended suspension through the 1st nine weeks of the 2016-2017 school term with Alternative Education, after that the parent can request a hearing to request to return with a behavior contract.

Upon a motion by Mr. Payne, seconded by Dr. Clark and by unanimous vote the board approved the superintendents recommendation.
