SPECIAL Meeting Minutes
November 28, 2016
9:00 a.m.

1. Roll Call

The Summers County Board of Education met in a special meeting on November 28, 2016, 9:00 a.m. in the board office conference room with Ms. Sue Angell, board president, presiding over the meeting with the following board members present: Dr. Austin Lilly, Dr. Deborah Clark, Mr. Robert Angell, and Mr. James Payne.

Other staff members present: Ms. Kimberly Rodes, Superintendent; Dr. Linda Knott, Director; Mr. Eric Widdoes, Director; Mr. Josh Houchins, Director; and Mrs. Jennifer Farley, Business Manager.

2. Invocation/Pledge of Allegiance

The invocation was given by Dr. Lilly followed by the Pledge of Allegiance.

3. Approval of Agenda

Upon a motion by Dr. Lilly, seconded by Mr. Payne and by unanimous vote, the agenda was approved.

4. Expulsion Hearing

Student ID#260015135 - Summers County High School

5. Discussion and/or Action Concerning Expulsion

Mrs. Vicars presented the facts in the case of the student #260015135 and she recommended expulsion to the end of the 3rd nine weeks with a behavior contract for the 4th 9 weeks.

Dr. Clark made a motion to go into executive session, pursuant to 6-9A-4, seconded by Mr. Angell, and by unanimous vote.

Upon returning to regular session Ms. Rodes recommended expulsion for the remainder of the 2016-2017 school year for the violation of 18-A-D-1a, *The Schools Laws of West Virginia and the Summers County Policy VII-A-10, Expected Behavior in Safe and Supportive Schools*. The student may ask to be readmitted for the 4th nine weeks prior to March 10th and must show that he has attended anger management.

Mr. Angell made a motion to approve the superintendent's recommendation, Mr. Payne seconded the motion and it passed unanimously.

Upon a motion by Dr. Clark, seconded by Mr. Payne the meeting was adjourned.
