**SUMMERS COUNTY SCHOOLS JOB DESCRIPTION**  
**Drama Coach**

**I. Position: Drama Coach**

**II: Definition: A person employed to provide instruction and direction to students, individually or as a group, for the purpose of developing their dramatic skills.**

**III. Responsibilities:**

- a. Implements extracurricular program**
- b. Fosters a climate conducive to participation**
- c. Utilizes coaching techniques which increase student skills and maximizes time on tasks**
- d. Monitors student progress toward dramatic achievements**
- e. Promotes and maintains positive student-teacher-parent relationships**
- f. Maintains professional work habits**

**IV. Duties:**

- a. Organize and carry out a drama program that will promote school pride**
- b. Accept the responsibility for the welfare of the students under the coach's supervision**
- c. Be concerned as an educator in the total school program and not isolate the drama program from the rest of the school**
- d. Be aware of a coach's responsibility in the area of public relations**
- e. Accept the responsibility for the behavior and welfare of his/her students and staff; before, during and after practices and performances**
- f. Accept responsibility for the retention and care of equipment**

**V. Qualifications:**

- a. Must be certified to teach in WV and assigned as a teacher in the Summers County School System, or employed as a substitute teacher**

**VI. Organizational Relationships:**

- a. Directly responsible to school's principal**
- b. Supervisory responsibility to the assistants and volunteers**
- c. Ultimate responsibility to superintendent of schools**
